The Parish House will be closed.

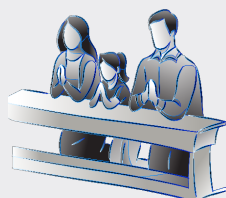
One Mass will be celebrated in the Church at 8:30 AM.
